

Family Acroporidae Key to Acroporid Genera

No axial corallite

- -Corallites < 2 mm diameter, columella absent
- --Branches without basal structures= *Anacropora*
- --Branches with basal structures = *Montipora*
- -Corallites obvious, columella present = *Astreopora*

Axial corallites on branch ends =Genus *Acropora*

Key to Astreopora

Corallites <1.5 mm, on mounds = Astreopora suggesta*

Corallites >1.5 mm, conical, evenly distributed

- -coenosteum papillae form ridges = Astreopora gracilis
- -coenosteum papillae perpendicular = $Astreopora\ myriophthalma$
